We Have Homework Help!

Live Homework Help is now available for students and adult learners through the Weston Public Library website at www.westonpubliclibrary.com. With your barcoded library card, you can access online tutors every day from 2-9 p.m. for one-on-one help with homework. Professors will help students in math, science, English. Tutors will also be available for adult learners of all ages with courses, resumes projects.



The student and tutor use a two-way whiteboard for math problems. The student sees the tutor's first name and last initial. No more identifying information is shared. All tutors have passed criminal background checks, and parents can rest assured that the site is safe for children to use.

The Chalkboard Project, a consortium of several major Oregon foundations, has provided funding through LEO (Libraries of Eastern Oregon) to bring Live Homework Help to all Eastern Oregon public libraries for the next 18 months. Stop by the library, or call 566-2378 for more information or assistance with this new feature.

Professionally trained tutors help grades K-12 with math and social studies. Tutors are also available to help adult learners with GED and adult education-related projects.

Homework Help also includes a whiteboard, which is helpful for students to communicate with their tutor. The student sees the tutor's first name and last initial.
