## Concert in the Park

Legendary folk singer, storyteller and autoharp virtuoso Adam Miller will perform a **free concert** of traditional folksongs, stories and autoharp instrumentals at **7:00 p.m. Monday, August 11 in the Weston Park**. This program is sponsored by an Oregon State Library Ready to Read Grant and Weston Public Library.

One of the premier autoharpists in the world, Adam Miller is a renowned folk singer and natural born storyteller. He has amassed an amazing repertoire of over 5,000 songs. Miller accompanies his rich baritone voice with lively finger picking acoustic guitar and beautiful autoharp melodies. A masterful entertainer who never fails to get his audience singing along, he has distinguished himself to be one of the great interpreters of American folktales and folksongs, and as a performer who appeals to audiences

of all ages. Miller's time-honored traditional folksongs and ballads are a breath of fresh air. His songs evoke a by-gone time when entertainment was homemade.

Miller travels 70,000 miles each year performing in concert halls from the Everglades to the Arctic Circle. Bring a chair or blanket, and join us in the park to welcome Adam Miller on Monday, August 11 at 7:00 p.m..
