Library Statistics

At the end of each fiscal year, the annual library statistics from each public library in Oregon are collected. This report is used as a tool for local and state administrators to make decisions about future library services and programs. Once again our report has been filed with the Oregon State Library. Here are some examples of numbers reported by Weston Public Library for FY 2013-2014:

- * Number of registered borrowers= 406
- * Number of print items in our collection= 9,778
- * Number of audios= 417
- * Number of videos= 249
- * Total circulation of materials= 4,736
- * Number of e-book titles available through

Library2Go=30,806

- * Number of audio book titles available through Library2Go= 21,575
- * Number of programs held= 81
- * Total program attendance= 770
- * Items loaned to other libraries= 608
- * Items borrowed from other libraries= 439
- * Number of public computer uses= 470

100 Years Ago in Weston

November 11, 1914

Weston cast much the largest vote in its history, which totaled 276 in Weston and 146 in East Weston precinct. The town favored the citizenship amendment, and gave a large vote to both

the normal schools. Only 9 votes were cast against the Weston Normal, and only 30 against the Ashland Normal. The vote on prohibition was 258 for and 105 against. All other measures were beaten except the dentistry bill, which received a heavy vote. Joe Lieuallen was elected

justice of the peace and Henry Stamper as constable, the latter without opposition. The name of Frank Snider for justice of the peace was written on the ballot by a considerable number of voters, cards having been circulated by friends in his behalf.
