Get to Know Your E-Reader

Maybe you got a new e-reader or mp3 player for Christmas. If Santa brought you a new device, do you know how to get free downloads from your library? Now you can learn to checkout and download the hottest eBooks to your computer or portable device, or audio books to your mp3 player or phone, during a demonstration of the Library's free downloadable service, Library2go.

A resident expert on e-readers and audio devices will be at the Weston Public Library Thursday, January 15 at 5:30. We are prepared to help you with tips and tricks for using Library2go.

Thanks to a cooperative purchasing effort, the Umatilla County Special Library District arranged a group subscription to Library2go for all twelve city libraries in our district. This was accomplished in partnership with the Libraries of Eastern Oregon, with no cost to users.

Library2go has a huge catalog of books

and audiobooks available for you to download to your devices. You can check out these materials 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and never worry about late fees. The service is easy to use- you need your digital device, your library card in good standing with your PIN, and an internet connection. The link is available on the Weston Public Library website.

Bring your device to the library January 15 at 5:30, and we'll help you find out how!
