Getting a library card is easy. Simply visit the library, fill out a short application form, and provide identification showing your current residency with a Weston address. Minors under the age of 18 will need a parent or guardian's signature to get a library card.

New library card holders (kids and adults) will receive a coupon good for a free cup of coffee or ice cream cone from Central Station. If you already have a library card, tell your

friends and family to sign up.
