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## Book Group: *Novel Readers*

A dozen or so years ago (we can't remember the year, exactly) a few avid readers asked if the Library could form a book discussion group. These folks began meeting the last Thursday evening of each month. We call this group "*Novel Readers.*"

Here's how it works. The librarian rounds up multiple copies of a particular book, members check them out and read at home. On the designated evening, we gather in the library for a discussion.

Over the years, we have read a vastly diverse list of books. We began by selecting novels, thus the name of the group. Since then, we have branched out to include nonfiction, young adult books, and inspirational fiction. What qualities make a book a good candidate for discussion? Probably the most important criteria are that the book be well written, have an interesting plot and three-

dimensional characters. A good book-discussion book often stays in the reader's mind long after the book is finished and the discussion is over. These books can be read more than once, and each time the reader learns something new.
