Historic Photos at the Library

The subjects are the first Pioneer Picnic attendees in 1892, an early Pioneer Picnic gathering, Armistice Day 1918 in Weston, a horse and buggy from the early 1900s, with Eastern Oregon State Normal School in the background, and an image of the first woman to vote in Weston in 1912.
